Indonesian Crisis Hardens; Rebels Sought

JAKARTA, Indonesia, Feb. 12 (AP)—Indonesia's politico-military crisis hardened today. Commercial flights to rebellious Central Sumatra were canceled.

The rebel officers, avowed foes of communism and corruption, broadcast an ultimatum from Padang Monday demanding that Djanda's "guided democracy" cabinet quit and President Sukarno name a new government within five days.

The rebels proposed that Hatta, a Sumatran who broke with Sukarno in 1956, and Sultan Hamengku, Indonesia's first defense minister, should head a caretaker regime of experts.

Djanda's cabinet rejected the ultimatum Tuesday night and ordered dishonorable discharge of the four young colonels.

They are Lt. Col. Achmad Husin, military commander of Central Sumatra; Lt. Col. Zulkifli Lubis and Lt. Col. Dahlan Djambek, former deputy chiefs of staff; and Col. Maludin Simbolon, ousted commander of North Sumatra.

They were accused of being involved in an attempt last November to assassinate President Sukarno and of trying to change the army chief's orders.

Tiny Zavada Quads Now 10 And Normal

LATROBE, Pa., Feb. 12 (AP)—Remember the Zavada quadruplets of Latrobe?

In 1948, the nation watched and wondered if they would survive. They were born so tiny, the biggest weighing only 2 pounds, 10 ounces.

"Now they are almost forgotten," said their mother, Mrs. Andrew Zavada, today as the four children prepared to celebrate their 10th birthday Saturday—hair and hearty.

"You'd never know to see them now that they had such a struggle," said their mother. "The neighbors and their friends accept them as though there was nothing unusual about their birth."

At birth the babies—three girls and a boy—tipped the scales at 1 pound, 2 ounces; 2 pounds, 4 ounces; 2 pounds, 6 ounces, and 2 pounds, 10 ounces.

Dr. Richard O'Toole, Pittsburgh pediatrician, traveled some 40 miles to Latrobe every day for three months to watch over the children.

Mrs. Zavada said the quads are "healthy kids," but she agreed the three petite blond-haired girls and their blond-haired brother are smaller than most children of 10.

Barbara, the smallest at birth, is still the tiniest. She weighs 58 pounds and is 50 inches tall. John is 34 inches tall and weighs 64 pounds. The two other girls, Bernadette and Anna Mary, both are 52 inches tall and weigh 58 pounds.

All are fourth-grade students at St. Vincent's Parochial School. The quads will celebrate with their 15-year-old brother, Larry, and 8-year-old sister, Frances.

Researchers Try To Create New Type Fluid Milk

CORVALLIS, Feb. 12 (AP)—Research programs are trying to create concentrated fluid milk that can be stored without refrigeration, the Oregon Dairy Industry Conference was told Tuesday.

Michael J. Pannansch said that the research programs are getting closer to finding such a fluid milk which can be brought up to the original milk quality by adding water.

Pannansch is a member of the U. S. Department of Agriculture research division. The conference ends tomorrow night.

Mardi Gras Gaiety Boosted by Snow

NEW ORLEANS, Feb. 12 (AP)—The only thing that could turn the mounds of this fun-seeking city from carnival gaiety on the eve of Mardi Gras happened today.

It snowed enough to measure for the first time in 20 years. Even sober citizens immune to the spirit of carnival grinned at the floating flakes of snow and the rare mantle of white over the blooming azaleas and camellias, the shrubs and the palm fronds.

The gay at heart scooped snow into balls and pitched them at everyone from traffic cops to the sedate banker.

Mid-Morning Freeze But, temperatures that dipped below freezing at midmorning forced cancellation of the horse races at Fair Grounds and the postponement until Saturday of tonight's scheduled downtown parade by the Carnival Krewe of Babylon.

Officials warned about highway travel in north Louisiana and New Orleans street crews watched the overpasses for dangerous ice.

The snow storm moved in from Texas and brought similar weather for much of the Deep South. The snow fall was heavier west of New Orleans.

Hurricane-wounded Cameron on the edge of the Gulf of Mexico stirred sluggishly under about five inches of snow and nearby Lake Charles measured about one inch. Baton Rouge had more than an inch.

Snow in Deep South Snow reports filtered in from extreme Deep South—snow trace at Natchez and Hattiesburg, Miss., a flurry at Pensacola, Fla., flurries around Mobile, Ala., and Biloxi, Miss., on the Gulf Coast.

Some counties west of New Orleans closed their schools. In New Orleans a forecast of a 28-degree minimum posed a threat of icy streets as snow continued to fall. There was a similar outlook in Mississippi.

In north Florida, forecasters looked for the second snow of the state's worst winter, a season which brought an estimated loss of a quarter of a billion dollars from bad weather.

"There are plans to stop them," the general was quoted by an unnamed source. He declined to amplify.

Albert S. Bigelow, 51, of Cos Cob, Conn., sailed Monday from Los Angeles with three companions. They plan to sail into the area where nuclear tests are scheduled for April.

The Defense Department said yesterday it was relying on the task force commander's judgment to prevent injury to the four men aboard the keelboat.
