

Aussie Lass Tops World Swim Mark

MELBOURNE, Feb. 20 (AP)—Despite a heavy cold, 13-year-old Lisa Konrads clipped 1.5 seconds off her world records for 800 yards and 800 meters tonight in winning the Australian women's free-style swimming championship.

The slender, Latvian-born blonde won by 80 yards in the 800-yard race (half-mile) with a time of 10 minutes, 16.2 seconds. Enroute, the youngster also bettered her 800-meter (875 yards) record in 10:09.6.

That made a total of 12 world record performances during the championships in the 55-yard Olympic pool.

Gerda Zevenboom, a 15-year-old Dutch girl swimming for South Australia, was second in 11:15.3. Christine O'Farrell was third in 11:16.1.

The smashing victory clinched a berth for Lisa on the Australian team which will participate in the Empire Games at Cardiff, Wales, this summer. Five nights ago she finished second to Olympic champion Dawn Fraser in the 400-yard final.

Lisa's 15-year-old brother, John, who previously had earned a berth on the Empire team by his victories in the 220 and 400-yard championships, passed up the men's 800-yard race. It was won by Gary Winram in the comparatively slow time of 9:46. John Kisan was second in 9:52 and 15-year-old Peter Curtis was third in 9:52.9.

John Konrads set the 800 record Jan. 11 at 9:17.7. He now holds six world records from 200 meters to 800 yards.
