Women's Conference Hears Hatfield Oppose Compulsory Auto Insurance

Secretary of State Mark Hatfield Saturday night expressed opposition to compulsory automobile insurance in a talk before the regional conference of the National Association of Insurance Women at Hotel Marion.

Hatfield advocated a four-point program for dealing with the problem of the uninsured motorist. He also urged that the combination insurance commissioner-fire marshal position be separated and a statewide fire training program for volunteer departments be re-organized and accelerated.

Hatfield's talk highlighted an evening banquet which capped a full day's schedule of business and social sessions for some 140 association members.

Earlier in the day members were greeted by acting Mayor Russell Bonesteel and Marion Hotel Manager Del Milne in behalf of the city. Mrs. Marion Walker, San Francisco, the association's 2nd national vice president also greeted delegates.

Honored guest at the night banquet was Regional Director Mrs. Sadie Ward, Tacoma. Other guests included Hugh Earle, state insurance commissioner; Richard Denton, Salem Insurance Agents Association; Herbert A. Ballin, president of Oregon Association of Insurance Agents; and Harold J. Westfall, president of Life Underwriters Association of Salem.

Mrs. George G. Martin, president of the West Salem Association, presided at the banquet.

Today's concluding conference program will include an 8:30 a.m. breakfast and a morning business session, which will include election of a new regional director, appointments for national and regional committee chairmen and bids for the 1960 convention.

In his talk, Hatfield said \$32,326,303 was paid out in 1956 for auto liability insurance. He said a proposal that such insurance be deductible on income tax returns would result in a loss of an estimated half million dollars in revenue to the state "and offers nothing constructive toward alleviation of the problem."

Lana Turner Pays Surprise Visit to Daughter

LOS ANGELES (U-P) Actress Lana Turner, recovering from the ordeal of her dramatic recital of John Stompanato's fatal stabbing, paid a surprise visit to her 14-year-old daughter, Cheryl, Saturday, to see her in court. The girl, normally, visitors are not permitted at juvenile hall on Saturday, but the rule was waived so that Sunday's visiting routine would not be disturbed, said juvenile authorities. The girl's father, restaurateur Stephen Crane, called on her later in the day. When told that the inquest had absolved her, Cheryl said: "My prayers have been answered."

The jury's verdict is not binding upon Santa Monica Juvenile Court Judge Allen T. Lynch. He will conduct the hearing to determine whether Cheryl is to remain with her mother, be given into the custody of her father, the second of Lana's four husbands, be given to Miss Turner's mother, Mrs. Mildred Turner, or placed in a private institution.

Judge Lynch could certify the girl as an adult, leaving the door open for her prosecution for Stompanato's death.

Dist. Atty. William H. McKesson indicated there would be no prosecution, however.

After her visit, Miss Turner told reporters: "We didn't cry. We were too happy to see each other. Cheryl is looking fine. They are treating her wonderfully here."

The actress says she intends to visit Cheryl often.
