

# U.S. Pavilion Top Draw at World's Fair

BRUSSELS—Nearly half a million visitors jammed the World's Fair in sunny weather Sunday, trying to get in apparently having a wonderful time.

Every pavilion that was open had record crowds. Belgian guides said the U.S. pavilion with its live fashion models was still outdrawing them all. The Russians were a close second with their Sputnik show.

Thousands witnessed the official opening of the Vatican's first exhibition at the World's Fair. Msgr. Ephraim Ferni, papal nuncio to Brussels, inaugurated the Holy See's impressive building entitled "Civitas Dei"—City of God.

One of the fair's most striking pieces of modern architecture, the Vatican's pavilion is a church in the shape of a long-tapered triangle built to hold 2,500 persons. It is 62 feet high. When the fair closes Oct. 19 it will be dismantled and reassembled somewhere else.

# German Visit By Elizabeth Draws Denial

BONN, Germany—A government spokesman has denied a published report that Chancellor Konrad Adenauer has invited Britain's Queen Elizabeth II to make a state visit to Bonn.

The London Sunday Express said Adenauer extended an invitation that was entertained at a royal banquet in London last week. Not so, a Bonn spokesman said Sunday.

He added, however, that the West German government certainly would welcome a visit by Britain's Queen.

# Way Cleared Through Pass

SEATTLE—Stevens Pass was reopened to one-way traffic at 11:30 a.m. Sunday after being closed by slides since late Saturday.

John Stackhouse, maintenance engineer at State Highway Department headquarters at Olympia, reported that the first hole was punched through the 600-foot slide area at 11:30 a.m. and traffic started through 20 minutes later. He had gone to the scene from Olympia to supervise the work.

He said two slides occurred about half a mile apart at spots where similar ones had caused trouble in the past. One, in the Big Windy area, brought down much rock with the snow and the other, Old Faithful, was mostly snow.

Two rotary snowplows, a bulldozer, a motor patrol blade and a half yard truck showed up in the clearing operation he said.

The pass was closed by the slides late Saturday. Long lines of traffic, including cars containing scores of fishermen eastbound for Sunday's season opening, soon piled up.

# Schweitzer Talks Due

OSLO—Norway's short-wave radio network will broadcast three lectures by Dr. Albert Schweitzer on the theme "Peace or Atomic War."

The lectures will be carried April 28, 29 and 30. Their titles are: "Stop Nuclear Weapons Tests," "Renounce Atomic Weapons" and "Summit Negotiations."

# Atom Smasher Planned Felt in Chile Cities

CAIRO—An authoritative Egyptian source says the most powerful atom smasher in the Middle East is being installed at Inchas, northeast of Cairo, and will be in operation in a few weeks.

The informant said it will generate three million volts of electric current. The atom smasher and an atomic reactor also to be installed at Inchas both were imported from the Soviet Union, he said.
