More Marion County Vote Results Reported

Several more Marion County school districts reported voting returns Tuesday, following the school elections of Monday. These included:

GATES — Residents here approved a \$50,051 local school budget by a vote of 34 to 14 Monday and elected Jack Gullford to a five year term as director and Robert Oliver to a three year term. Both directors were unopposed. Last year's budget was \$47,683.

HAZEL GREEN — Voters here voted against the county school budget by 11 to 5 margin, but approved the local school budget by a vote of 13 to 3.

SHAW — George R. Bradley was favored by Shaw voters for Marion County rural school board director, receiving 11 votes to four for Dean Bishop and one for Harry Oldenburg. The vote went 11 to 4 against the proposed countywide budget.

MARI LINN — A \$65,000 school budget was passed here by a vote of 77 to 24. Hugh Johnston was elected over Mrs. Charlotte Theil for a five year term on the school board by a vote of 50 to 24.

BUENA CREST — A special election Monday resulted in 13-9 approval for Buena Crest Grade School District's budget of \$15,175. The budget was about \$300 under last year's.

William Downer won unopposed for a five-year term on the district board was Felix Hagging.

BROADACRES — The \$13,275 budget of Broadacres Grade School District passed by a unanimous 25 votes Monday. The budget was \$7,257 above the six per cent limitation.

Elected to a five-year term on the district board was Felix Hagging.

BUTTEVILLE — One-sided 39-3 approval was won by the \$13,752 budget of Butteville Grade School Monday.

Fred Wilmes was elected unopposed to a five-year term on the district board and James Johnson will fill an unexpired one-year term.
