

Bandits Stage \$100,000 Robbery, May Be Linked to Brutal Holdup

BEVERLY HILLS, Calif. (AP)—Two young bandits who staged a \$100,000 robbery of a Beverly Hills millionaire may be linked with a recent brutal Culver City market holdup, police said Thursday.

The two men, masked by heavy theatrical makeup, strode into the home of Samuel Hayden, 74, shortly before Wednesday midnight. They terrorized Hayden and his wife, Ann 52, and fled with approximately \$90,000 in furs, \$90,000 worth of jewelry and \$400 in cash. Police Chief Clinton H. Anderson and Detective Capt. Ray Borders said that two similarly disguised men robbed the U.S. Foods Market of \$6,000 eight days ago.

School Year Can't Start Earlier Due to State Fair

Problems found in treatment and care of Fairview Home patients was topic of a panel discussion held Thursday night at a meeting of Salem Association for Retarded Children at Hollywood Lions Den. The panel, comprised of Fairview attendants, pointed out the great amount of attention required for some patients. One cottage of 236 patients has 45 attendants. But sufficient help still is a problem in the institution of approximately 2,000 patients, it was reported. Man Fails to Get Damages in Shooting

EUGENE (AP) — A circuit court jury Thursday night decided that Charles Graves was not entitled to the \$100,000 he sought in a damage suit against Lane County Sheriff Ed Elder and Sheriff's Deputy E. J. Robertson. Graves contended in the suit that Elder and Robertson were negligent in having him remain in his side of a duplex during a gun battle between police and Albert Lewis Wachsmuth the night of Feb. 22, 1957. Wachsmuth lived in the other side of the duplex. The gun battle ensued after Wachsmuth shot Sheriff's Deputy David Heiner, who, with Robertson, was called to the Wachsmuth home to investigate a family disturbance. Later Wachsmuth shot and killed State Policeman Charles Sanders and for this he was sentenced to life imprisonment.

Food Markets To Reopen in Sunday Issue

ALBANY, Ore. (AP) — Safeway food markets in Lebanon and Sweet Home will reopen Sunday, despite efforts of a grocer-minister group to leave Linn County stores closed on the Sabbath. District manager for Safeway, D. O. Bevans, said Thursday that the stores will follow the lead of four Albany markets, which opened for business last Sunday. All major markets in the county agreed in March to close Sundays. But the program has broken down recently. One of the Safeway stores which opened last Sunday was picketed by representatives of the grocer-minister committee on Sunday closing.

Hoosiers Halt Major Flood Breakthrough

PERU, Ind. (AP) — Peru staved off a major breakthrough of the worst Wabash River flood in 15 years Thursday, but forecasts of possibly heavy weekend rains threatened worse flooding downstream as far as Terre Haute. Flooding of thousands of acres of farmlands indicated crop damage may amount to millions of dollars. Sandbagging continued at frantic pace in Peru although the river began a slow decline after its crest at 23.11 feet at 3 a.m.

Labor Reform Bill Revised To Meet Ike's Criticisms

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Senate Thursday revised a labor reform bill to meet some of the Eisenhower administration's criticisms. Most of the changes were accepted with little opposition. After more than 12 hours of debate, however, the Senate adjourned until Friday without attempting to tackle the most controversial issues involved in the legislation. The only close vote came on an attempt of Sen. Barry Goldwater (R-Ariz.) to strike from the bill a section narrowing the Taft-Hartley Act's definition of supervisory employees. Goldwater's amendment to erase this part of the bill was defeated 47-38 on a roll-call vote.

Big Sub Sighted Off Chile

VALPARAISO, Chile (AP)—The Chilean navy said Thursday a big submarine was sighted Friday off the north Chilean port of Tocopilla. Rear Adm. Raul Rudolph, director of coastal defenses, said the sub submerged after it was spotted by fishing boats. The newspaper La Estrella said the vessel was Russian and probably supplied by the Ob, a Soviet supply ship taking part in International Geophysical Year studies. There was no official confirmation of the newspaper's report. On May 27, the Brazilian navy reported one of its destroyers had contacted a suspected submarine off the coast near Rio de Janeiro. A week earlier, Argentine warships made a depth charge attack on a mystery submarine off Argentina's southern coast.
