

# Eclipse of Sun Due April 29th

BERKELEY, Calif., April 22 (U) — The northern part of the United States from Portland, Ore., to Minneapolis will see a partial eclipse of the sun April 29, weather permitting.

Alaska and western Canada may see a considerable part of the solar disc obliterated. Anyone within 300 miles of the North Pole at the time will see it as an annular or "ring" eclipse.

In a ring eclipse the moon is squarely between the sun and the observer but the lunar body is not big enough to cover the entire solar disc, so a bright ring of sun shines around the moon is seen.

The eclipse will be of little importance to astronomers, said Dr. Leland Cunningham of the University of California, but it may hold some interest for radio telescopic observations.

At Seattle the eclipse will start at 5:55 p. m., Pacific Standard time and will continue until 6:14 p. m. About one-seventh of the solar disc will be obscured there. Only one-tenth of the disc will be obscured at Portland where the eclipse will begin at 3:15 p. m. Cities to the east of there will see still less of the moon's shadow and shorter intervals of obscuration. At Minneapolis the eclipse will begin at 7:02 p. m., Central standard time, and will be cut off almost immediately by the sun set.

Denver is about the southernmost city for seeing anything. About one-twentieth of the solar disc will be affected there. Boise and Helena will be in the path of partial eclipse.

# Plan Revision For John Day Dam Approved

WASHINGTON, April 22 (U) — An Army Engineer proposal to revise plans for construction of John Day Dam on the Columbia River has been approved by the Senate Public Works Committee.

Sen. Magnuson (D-Wash.) today made public a letter by Sen. Chavez (D-N.M.), chairman of the committee, stating that the group feels the proposed change is within the discretion of the engineers to make.

Under the proposal controlled storage behind the proposed dam would be reduced from 2 million acre feet because of possible difficulties in navigation and fish culture.

It would have no effect on the dam's estimated 1,250,000 kilowatt power potential.

Magnuson said Chavez' letter to Army Secretary Brucker eliminates the possibility that the proposed John Day modification might require congressional action, thereby delaying efforts to obtain money with which to start construction this year.

Army Engineers expect to complete pre-construction planning on the Columbia River Dam by July 1 and have advised Magnuson that they could use as much as \$3 million dollars for construction in the year beginning July 1.

# Pickets Stay At New Bridge

VANCOUVER, Wash., April 22 (U) — Picket lines remained at the new Interstate Bridge today as union pile-driver operators continued their jurisdictional dispute with another union.

About 100 men were idled last Thursday when pile-driver operators began picketing in protest over ironworkers driving piling for the bridge's falsework.

# Woman Knocked Into Phone Wires in Crash

OTTAWA, April 22 (U) — Barbara Fraser, 30, was thrown from an overturning car on the highway near here. She flew 20 feet in the air and dangled by telephone wires for eight minutes. Several ribs were broken when she hit a telephone pole crossbar in flight. But when she dropped from the wire, she suffered no further injury.

# Boy Plunges to His Death Down Granite Mountain

ATLANTA, April 22 (U) — Michael Moret, 15, of New York City plunged to his death down a 500-foot sheer granite side of Granite Mountain today while spectators watched helplessly. Witnesses said the youth slipped about on the mountain crest about 15 minutes, grasping pieces of moss and brush to slow his fall, before plunging over a ledge to his death.

His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Sidney S. Moret, were waiting in their car at the foot of the mountain. Returning from a visit here, they had detoured by Stone Mountain to give their son a chance to climb the huge monolith.

The crumpled body was recovered just north of an unfinished monument of Confederate heroes chiseled in the mountain side.

# Poison Brings Experimental Farm's Move

MEDFORD, April 22 (U) — Jackson County Wednesday will be asked to move a state experimental farm whose experiments are being hampered by poisonous deposits in the soil.

The farm now is at Talent, and crop experiments are conducted on land where an orchard once stood. The soil has heavy deposits of arsenate of lead the trees were sprayed with over a long period.

This lead has hampered the experiments, conducted to find crops that will grow well in this area. The Jackson County Court has urged that 80 acres of land be purchased for a new farm near Jacksonville. The estimated price is \$54,000.

If the plan is approved, the county would purchase the land, but most other farm costs would be paid by the state.
