

New Drug Tops Quinine in Aid For Malaria

WASHINGTON, Jan. 4. —(AP)—American scientists reported yesterday development of a new synthetic drug called superior to atabrine or quinine for malaria.

Termed "SN 7618," it relieves acute attacks of the disease three times faster than the other two drugs, according to the board for the coordination of malarial studies.

In addition, the board said, it can be taken weekly instead of daily to keep the disease in a mild state, doesn't stain the skin as does atabrine, doesn't cause buzzing in the ears as does quinine, and doesn't make the patient sick at his stomach as the other two drugs sometimes do.

At the same time the scientists disclosed that another new drug was offering "definite promise" of being the long-sought actual cure for the relapsing of malaria—the type with which many returning servicemen are afflicted. They did not identify the drug specifically.

Neither drug is available to the public yet. The latter of the two is still in an early experimental stage.

Research
Both developments resulted from a \$5,000,000 wartime research program in which 14,000 compounds were tested seeking improved weapons against the malarial which strikes up to 300,000,000 persons throughout the world annually.

Conscientious objectors and prison inmates participated as volunteer "human guinea pigs," allowing themselves to be infected with the disease and treated. Several hundred thousand canary birds, ducks, chickens, monkeys, dogs, rabbits and mice were used in laboratory tests.

The first drug has been employed successfully in 5,000 human cases of malaria, including more than 1,000 in the armed forces, the scientists said, but they would not recommend its release to civilians until further trials are made.

7000 Tests
In the American research, some 7000 different chemical compounds ordinarily used for such purposes as making nylon, fertilizers, synthetic rubber and other products were tested for anti-malarial activity.

Meanwhile, 7000 other compounds were synthesized in University and industrial laboratories.

The compounds first were tried on birds infected with malaria, and tests of the toxicity of various compounds were made on monkeys and other animals. Eighty compounds out of the 14,000 eventually were tested in humans.

Cons Volunteer
Human volunteers for the tests were inmates of the federal penitentiary at Atlanta, Ga.; state penitentiary, Joliet, Ill.; the New Jersey state reformatory at Rahway; the army disciplinary barracks at Greentown, N.Y.; and conscientious objectors stationed at Massachusetts General hospital and Goldwater Memorial hospital, New York.

In addition, certain patients in psychiatric hospitals who normally are infected purposely with malaria as "fever treatment" for certain illnesses, were given test drugs in "innocuous dosages" to enable doctors to study the efficacy of the drugs.

Grain Market Futures Lose Up to 24 Cents

CHICAGO, Jan. 4. —(AP)—Liquidation and hedge selling found meager demand in grain futures trading today and prices dragged out at fractions to as much as 2½ cents a bushel below yesterday's close.

Rallying strength was scarcely apparent at any time in the dull session with most offerings and bids coming from local traders. Brokers said many commission houses preferred to await reports on country marketing of grain since the first of the year and to see if the volume is increasing sufficiently, as expected, to relieve the short supply condition.

One report which induced more active selling of all grains near the close of the session was that more corn and oats have been acquired recently than advised.

Wheat closed unchanged to ½ cent lower than the previous finish, May \$1.80½; corn unchanged at \$1.18½; oats ½ cent lower, May 75½-¾; rye ½ cent lower, May \$1.72½-¾; barley ¼ higher to ½ lower, May \$1.21½.

President Truman's speech was discounted as a trading factor, brokers said, adding that the market continued to be "touchy" with minor influences either way sufficient to move prices.

Timid Rally in Stock Market

NEW YORK, Jan. 4. —(AP)—Selected rails and industrials negotiated a timid rally in today's stock market, although many leaders failed to climb out of the losing column and dealings were relatively sluggish.

Improved tendencies appeared after an irregularly lower opening, with carriers favored. Transfers of 1,070,000 shares compared with 1,390,000 Thursday.

Bidding dropped up on the idea that the list might be hovering around a temporary bottom. Accounts again were lightened, however, because of spreading strikes and thoughts of an extended technical correction of the recent swing to 15-year peaks. President Truman's broadcast provided scant purchasing stimulation.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was unchanged at 74.6.
