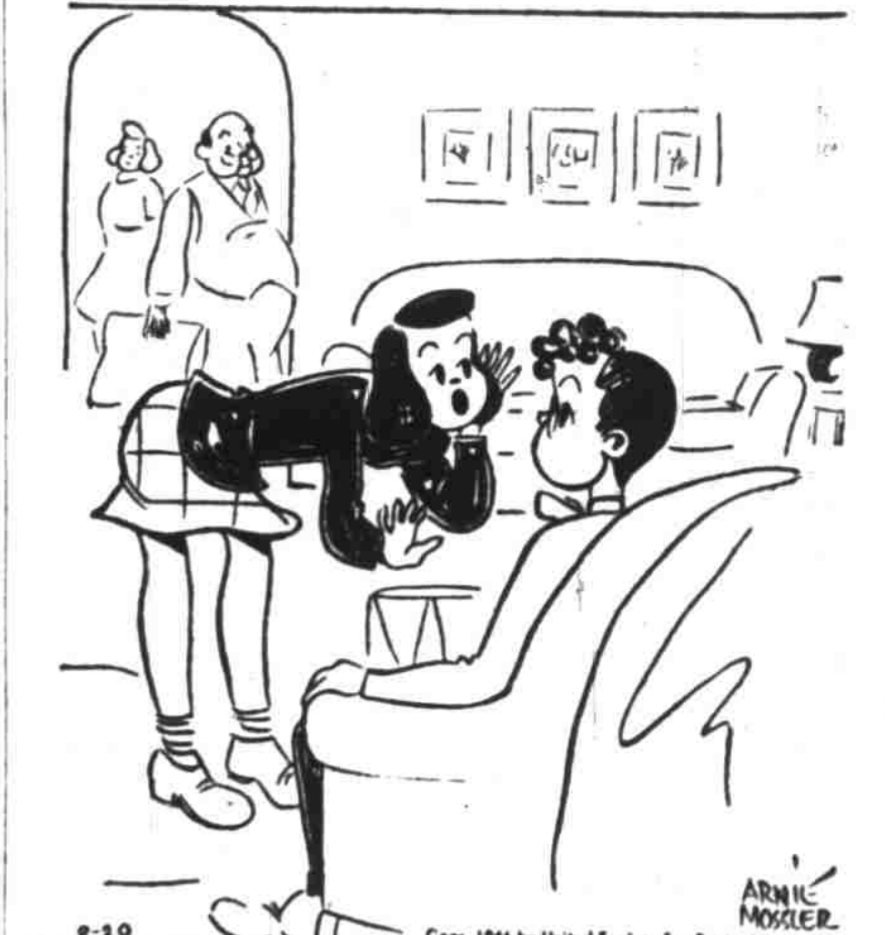

Stock Market Continues Fast Trend Down

NEW YORK, Feb. 20 (AP) The third successive day of tumbling prices sliced 7 to 7 points off leading stocks in today's market. While the pace of the decline slowed appreciably from Tuesday's precipitate drop, the downturn has wiped out nearly 35 per cent of the average gain made by stocks in the climb to 15-year peaks since the Japanese surrender last August.

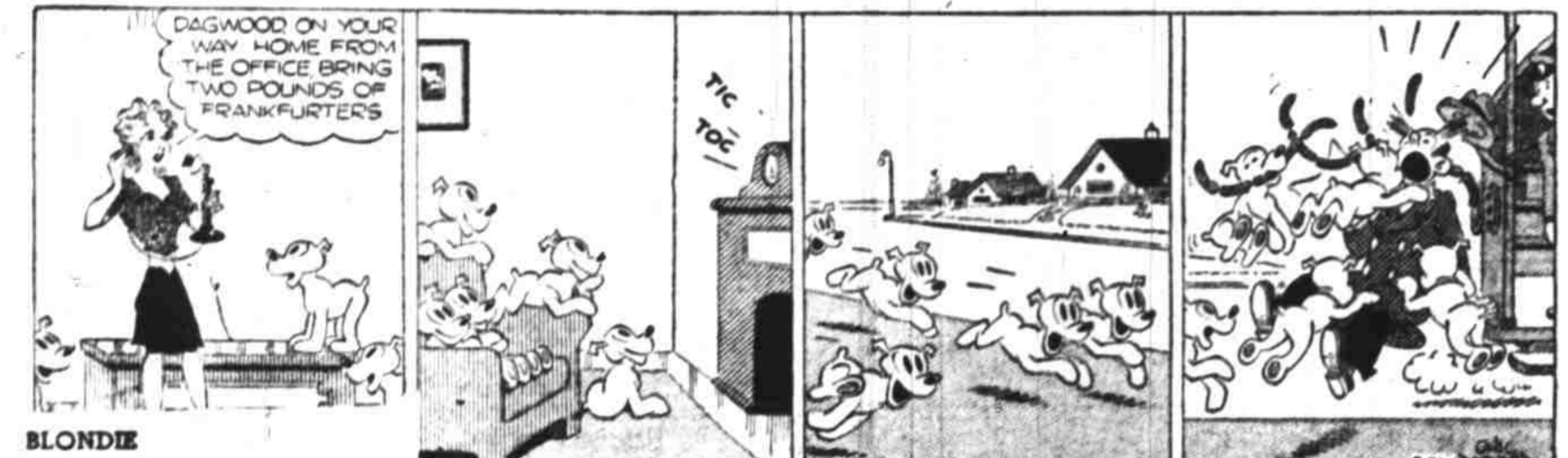
