

## German Slave Mart Revealed By Russians

NUERNBERG, Feb. 22—(AP)—Nazi Germany created slave markets to sell captive Russians at 10 to 15 marks a head (\$4 to \$6 at pre-war exchange) and subjected imported Polish workers to sterilization and prostitution, the Soviet prosecution charged today at the trial of 22 ranking nazis.

Prosecutor N. D. Zorya presented to the international military tribunal letters from German families to menfolk at the front describing the fate of some of the thousands of Russians moved into the Reich from occupied territory in the east.

He read a press statement attributed to Fritz Sauckel, Nazi chief of manpower conscription, declaring that in 1942 alone 2,000,000 slaves were rounded up from the Soviet Union.

Zorya said another 2,000,000 workers were conscripted from Poland, and declared this figure "conceals an ocean of broken lives."

## Nazi Musician Invited To Resume Career

VIENNA, Feb. 22—(AP)—The Austrian artistic commission which has been considering the case of Wilhelm Furtwaengler, former director of the Berlin philharmonic orchestra, has decided to invite him to resume his musical career in Vienna.

The decision must be approved by a special commission of the four occupying powers. He has been barred from the American zone in Germany because it was charged he used his talents to further nazism.

## Columbia County Paid \$28,000 for Oil Leases

ST. HELENS, Feb. 22—(AP)—Columbia county has something approaching an oil well, while the Texas company is still uncertain about its status.

The county has received \$28,000 so far this year on oil leases to the company, which expects to determine whether oil underlies the area.

## VA Seeking to Use Klamath Base Hospital

KLAMATH FALLS, Feb. 22 (AP)—The veterans administration wants to use the Klamath Falls Marine barracks dispensary as a 150-bed veterans' hospital, officials at the barracks said today.

They added that VA use of the dispensary would not interfere with use of the barracks as an educational institution if the state decided to accept the buildings to relieve overcrowding in other colleges.

Governor Snell, representatives of the state board of higher education and the emergency board are expected here tomorrow to inspect the barracks for possible use.

Officials here said the dispensary did not conform to VA standards for veterans' hospitals and it probably would be used on a temporary basis pending construction of a regular hospital here, plans for which were announced some weeks ago.

THREE WAYS TO FILE

A. simplified withholding receipt your employer gives you. Usually you may use this if your pay was less than \$5,000.

B. SHORT CUT: The short B form 1040. (If you earned less than \$5,000, no matter how you earned it.)

C. LONG WAY ROUND: The long form 1040 must be used if your income was above \$5,000, or if your deductions come to more than ten per cent of total income. But anyone MAY use it.
