It was seventy-five years ago, the 10th day of June, that the first Masonic body in Eugene was chartered.

The body is what is now known as Eugene Lodge No. 11, A. F. & A. M. The charter which it received in 1856 anti-dates the chartering of the grand lodge of Oregon itself.

Masonry has played an important part in the development of the city and of the state.

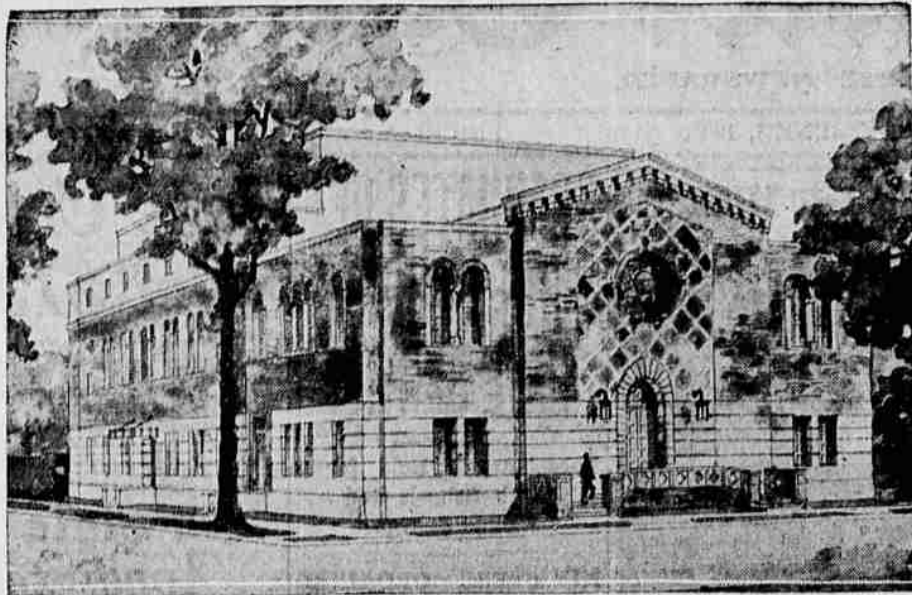
