**DRIVERS' LICENSE EXAMINATIONS SET JUNE, JULY DATES**

A schedule showing the times at which state automobile drivers' license examinations will be available in Eugene for those getting licenses under the new law was announced last week by Hal Hoss, secretary of state.

Examinations given at police headquarters in the city hall here. The examiner, Glenn Bown, will be present on the following dates:

Hoss has released the following information, giving in detail the procedure to be followed by operators and chauffeurs in obtaining licenses in the future under the amended operator's and chauffeur's license act.

**Chauffeurs Heretofore Licensed**  
Chauffeurs' licenses are issued for one year, or to expire on June 30, (The chauffeur's license fee was reduced by the last legislature from \$2 to \$1). Persons licensed as chauffeurs last year, are being mailed applications for their new licenses. The license is good for the period July 1, 1931, to June 30, 1932. The application is to be properly filled out, sworn to before a notary public, or other person authorized to administer an oath, mailed to the secretary of state with the fee of one dollar and license and have the same returned to the secretary.

(Examiners will have notarial commissions in about ten days and will administer this oath without charge).

Persons not heretofore licensed as chauffeurs and who desire a chauffeur's license will be examined by an examiner under the uniform operator's and chauffeur's license act, passed by the last legislature.

**Operator's Licenses**  
Operator's licenses, issued prior to June 1, 1931, will not be cancelled immediately, but will be cancelled within the next three years after due public notice. Until such time as they are cancelled they will be considered valid. Operators issued a license issued prior to July 1, 1931, may, on application to an examiner, secure a duplicate for \$5 or the applicant may, after July 1, 1931, have his old license cancelled and secure a new license under the new law, good for three years, after passing an examination and upon payment of a fee of 50 cents.

Persons who have never operated a car or who have never been licensed as an operator will be examined by an examiner under the uniform operator's and chauffeur's license act. Persons of minors under 18 years of age must be signed by father if living, and has custody of applicant, otherwise by mother or other person in legal charge. If applicant has neither father, mother or guardian, then application must be signed by employer.

After passing a test on the rules of the road, vision test, a color blind test and such other test as may be necessary to determine his ability to safely operate a car, he will, on payment of a fee of \$1, be issued a license, good for 60 days, only when accompanied in the front seat by a licensed operator. When the applicant has a car, he is able to safely drive a car, and his license is ready to sign to that effect, they apply to an examiner and the applicant is given an actual driving test on a city street, and on passing, the license is issued. Passing these tests before an examiner, his application is mailed to the secretary of state where it is checked and if regular, license is mailed direct to applicant. Applicants failing to pass the examination will be afforded further opportunities.

**Good Results Obtained In Demonstrations Of Weed Spraying in Lane**

One hundred twenty demonstrations on the use of sodium chlorate and atlacide in commercial calcium chloride weed killers were conducted in Lane county by the county agent, O. S. Fletcher, and co-operating farmers. Fifty similar demonstrations were conducted during 1929 and three in 1928. Results were variable every year but the results of three months work with chlorates in the county justify the following observations:

**Observations**  
All spraying was done with one pound of chlorate to one gallon of water, excepting a small amount of special trial work. The average amount of chemical used was three pounds per square rod. Atlacide dusts were used with three pounds per square rod. With few exceptions, good results were obtained with both Canada thistles and wild morning glory where the ground had not been plowed for a year or more before the spraying was done and where the plants had reached the full bloom stage before the first spray was applied. The chances of obtaining good kills were within one year of the date of spraying.

In every case where a good kill was obtained, the weeds were sprayed either two or three times. The sprays after the first being applied to plants that were not fully covered at first and to kill new growth.

Good kills of evergreen and Himalaya blackberry plants were secured where plants in full growth that had not been cut back were sprayed thoroughly after the berries had started to grow. Good results on blackberry plants.

Good kills of poison oak and wild rose were obtained where plants in full growth were sprayed thoroughly.

Best kills of all kinds of plants were obtained where there was a low growth of plants.

When sodium chlorate and atlacide were used side by side under identical conditions, there was little difference in results obtained. Possibly there was a slight difference in favor of sodium chlorate.

Dusting with atlacide when plants are in bloom appears to be as effective as spraying.

Chlorates applied dry to the soil in October, January, and March apparently gave as good results as summer spraying in four trials. January and March applications of chlorates gave similar results with wild morning glory.

Canada thistles were killed in one prime orchard by rather heavy spraying in late fall, early in 1929 and 1930 with no apparent effect on the trees. An apple tree and a cherry tree were killed in Cottage Grove while a heavy line spray was being successfully to kill evergreen blackberry plants.

No application of chlorates was 100 per cent effective the first year, but 1930 following the use of 40 pounds on a number of farms where the first spray was applied in 1929. Some clean-up work was necessary after the first spraying. Good results obtained the first year of treatment.

The best kills were obtained where power spraying outfits were used, possibly because there was a more uniform and more complete application of the chemical.

At least three Lane county spraying outfits caught fire from spontaneous combustion in 1930 following the use of sodium chlorate. There were two additional fires caused by friction on one of these outfits. The spontaneous

**Word Pioneers Group Formed in Eugene Saturday**

An organization to be known as the Fellowship of New World Pioneers was perfected in Eugene Saturday at a convention of delegates and visitors at the Community Liberal Club. Delegates came from Eugene and outlying communities in Lane and Linn counties.

The preamble, stating the purposes of such an organization, was adopted as follows:
