

Wheat Advances Cent; Stock Mart Fluctuates

TURKS RECEIVED FOR SHIPMENT TO EAST; EGGS STEADY

Wheat was boosted another cent here Monday, bringing it back to 45 cents.

Swift and company will receive turkeys again Tuesday, having started Monday for an eastern pre-thanksgiving shipment. Advanced prices paid are 13 cents, instead of 17 cents as announced, on No. 1 hens and toms; 10 cents on mediums, and 8 cents on No. 2 and old toms. Final settlement of price will be made after the turkeys are sold if they are sold for more.

Cabbage is down to 60 cents a hundred, buying price, and there is a lot of it on the market.

Butter, butterfat, livestock and other prices remained steady for the day.

Bright Spots

NEW YORK, Nov. 7.—(AP)—Southland Royalty Co. reported net income for nine months ended Sept. 30 was \$108,307, compared with \$77,193 in the first nine months of 1931.

CLEVELAND.—Steel operations have been stepped up to 21 per cent, against 19 1/2 per cent last week, according to the magazine "Steel."

TOLEDO.—Fifty-one major industrial plants reporting to the Merchants and Manufacturers association added 220 workers last week. Three hundred and eighty-eight were added in the preceding week.

EAST PITTSBURGH, Pa.—Refrigeration orders received by the Westinghouse Electric and Manufacturing Co. in September were 59 per cent over August and 17 per cent ahead of September, 1931.

BUTTER AND EGG PRICES STEADY

PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 7.—(AP)—Market for butter shows a generally steady tone although there is not much snap to the buying of 62s and higher. Local make is showing an increase but a decrease from the country is reflected.

General steadiness continues in the market for eggs. No change in the price was announced by E. J. Dixon, manager of the Pacific Co-ops. There is a slight decrease in eastern storage trade.

There was no change whatever in live chickens prices for the week's opening. Demand is good for hens but remains rather slow and weak for springer stuff. The latter is down a fraction again to a new low.

Market for country killed meats started the week without price or condition change. Veal remains in a very liberal offering and is inclined to show weakness. Hogs have held steady.

Increased movement of celery to the midwest and the southwest is taking care of all offerings. The wet weather has interfered somewhat with the movement from the farms. Sales chiefly 70c half cents in car lots.

Trading in onions at Oregon country points continues nominal with 35-40c central being offered but not acceptable to growers generally. No business appears possible at the moment beyond the spread.

There is some increase noted in the strength of tomatoes. Another carload of California came in and was priced 12 1/2c repeated bulk. This is a rise of 2c. Local outdoor is unchanged but buthouse is a fraction up.

Long expected carload of eastern cranberries made its appearance on the local market. The stock consisted of Cape Cod late lot, lowest quality, priced nominally \$3 quarter barrel box. There was no change in the price of local.

Lemons are down another half dollar a case, weaker. Oranges are unchanged. Limited supply of valley cantaloupes offerings \$1 crate.

Cauliflower market is steady with carlots more active.

Nut markets beginning to show signs of life locally. Shipping call for walnuts and filberts continues good.
