Davis Retrial to Start January 9

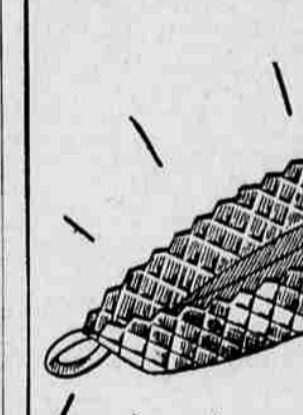
