COTTON PLANTER PAID WASHINGTON, July 28.—(AP)—President Roosevelt started a flow of more than \$100,000,000 into the cotton producing sections of the south today when he handed a check for \$517 to William E. Morris, stock farmer of Nueces county, Texas. Morris achieved his distinction by being the first cotton farmer in his county to sign a cotton reduction contract, and the first farmer in the country to begin plowing up his green cotton fields.
