

# FOREST FIRE IS HANDLED BY CCC

**OAKRIDGE, Aug. 19 — (Special)**—One of the largest forest fires in this district this week broke out, but was quickly controlled on Chinty Creek on High Prairie about 25 miles from Oakridge. The ten men who went into the fire found it difficult to keep from spreading until the 25 volunteers from the C. C. C. camp arrived. The fire was difficult to handle because it went down the hill instead of up as it was expected. It would do. The place is hard to get into as there is no road leading into it, and all the supplies had to be packed in on horses. The blaze spread to about 15 acres and was still burning the last of the week, but is under control. The men in charge of the fire stated that the C-C boys put up a good fight, even if they are inexperienced.
