

**LOW SCORE BUTTER
IS LOWER MONDAY**

PORTLAND, May 28—(P)—Only low score butter was lower for the week's opening sale here with the week-end session of the produce exchange quoting a cut of $\frac{1}{8}$ lb each in prime first and first. There was no change in butterfat.

Sale of low grade short-hold storage eggs was complicating the local situation somewhat inasmuch as some retailers buy such supplies on price alone and let the public worry about

Good demand was showing for light and medium weight hens here. In fact there was a scramble for such but heavies were slow.

Asparagus was down 25c to \$2.25 pyramid top.
