NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to the terms of Section 80, Chapter 5, of the Charter of the City of Eugene, Oregon, and Ordinance No. 8801 passed by the Common Council of the City of Eugene on the 24th day of September, A. D. 1934, and approved by the Mayor on the same day, a special municipal election will be held in said city on Tuesday, the 6th day of November, 1934, from the hour of eight o'clock in the morning to the hour of eight o'clock in the afternoon, and at said election the following proposed Charter Amendments and proposals will be submitted to the electors of said City for their approval or rejection:

A. An Act to amend the Charter of the city of Eugene by adding a new Chapter thereto, adding to the present powers of the Council the power to license, reg-

B. An Act authorizing and empowering the Common Council of the city of Eugene to issue general obligation bonds of the city of Eugene in the sum of \$78,630.00 to be designated "Eugene Funding Bonds," for the purpose of refunding the city's issued outstanding warrants bearing dates prior to March 14, 1932, and all in conformity and embracing the provisions of Chapter 22 of Oregon Laws for 1933.

C. An Act authorizing and empowering the City of Eugene by adding a new chapter thereto creating a Commission to be known as the "Board of Health," and defining the duties and powers of said Board.

 Precinct No. 13.—Congregation Church: All the area south of 13th and between Willamette and Ferry Streets.
 Precinct No. 14.—University High: All the area between 13th and 15th and Ferry and Universal Streets.
