ALFONSO'S LAST STAMP

ROYALTY in Europe suffered many degradations where the monarchist regimes, and the practice of the monarchist rulers with words that expressed their downfall. Below is a stamp issued originally in Spain, and Queen Victoria of Spain, and overprinted with the title of the new government that replaced the monarchist regime in 1931. In the case of this stamp of Spanish origin, all that had not been sold through the republic was formed were sent to Madrid to be purchased. "República Española," but they were never sold in Madrid, however. The Spanish Republic continued to use up the monarchist stamps by recharging them, while it also began issuing stamps of its own design, some of which paid tribute to the heroes of the revolution.
