CHRIST OF THE ANDES

NEW travelers see it; only an occasional airplane flies overhead; trains rumble through a tunnel 2000 feet underneath, yet a lone bronze statue of Christ has been standing since 1904 on the boundary line of Argentina and Chile, as a mark of the peaceful relationship these two countries have enjoyed. Near the summit of the Pass of Uspallata, in the Andes, 12,000 feet high, this unique statue stands 25 feet tall on a base about the same height. It had been cast from some old Spanish cannon by the Argentine Sculptor Mateo Alonso, and was offered to both nations by Bishop Benavente of Argentina.

Spain could have chosen no better subject than this for its issue of 1930 on the occasion of the Spanish-American Union in Seville. It appears also on an Argentine stamp of 1934.
