RUINS OF TWO CIVILIZATIONS

More than 20 centuries, a mysterious stone idol, about 10 feet tall, has stood facing the sea, on a level 12,500 feet above sea level. In Bolivia, Archaelogists say it is the sun-god of the Incas, but further they say it is a little.

This monolith, now fearfully damaged by bullets from rifles of the army, has been found near the ruins of the ancient city of Tiahuanaco. It is traced back to a great prehistoric race, the Incas, who lived in the highlands of Peru. It is believed that the Incas were the descendants of the Aymaras, who lived in the lowlands of Peru. The Incas were a great civilization, and their ruins are still to be seen in many places. The monolith is a very important discovery, and it is hoped that it will help to solve the mystery of the Incas.
