

Cheese Advances 3 Cents Here; Other Produce Active; Wall St. Brisk

WHEAT IS NOW 93 CENTS BUSHEL IN EUGENE MARKETS

Cheese has advanced 3 cents a pound in Eugene, according to a report from the Eugene Farmers' Creamery which manufactures this product. The price has gone up on both grades. The quotations to retailers are 22 cents a pound for single loaves and 21 cents in case lots while single trips are bringing 21 cents and in case lots 20 cents.

Wheat advanced another cent a bushel here Friday, the Eugene Mill and Elevator company offering 93 cents.

In quoting Eugene Co-operative prices the figures are prices to retailers and not buying prices as inadvertently stated Thursday.

STOCKS PUSH UP GOOD GAINS; RAIL ISSUES IN LEAD

NEW YORK, Aug. 7.—(AP)—Rail issues put on steam for the upgrade today and other groups followed for gains of fractions to around 3 points. The continued flow of cheerful news from the business and industrial front pushed traders aggressively to the buying side, Wall street circles said.

Carriers up fractions to around 2 points included Santa Fe, New York Central, Union Pacific, Baltimore & Ohio and Delaware & Hudson.

Prominent issues up fractions to 3 points or so were U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, Chrysler, General Motors, Montgomery Ward, Douglas Aircraft, Deere, Western Union, Johns-Manville, Westinghouse, General Electric and Radio.
