

# Buying Prices Of Eggs Down Cent; Stocks Irregular In Moderate Trading

## POULTRY ADVANCES CENT PER POUND IN LOCAL MARKET

Buying prices of eggs dropped a cent a dozen in the Eugene markets Wednesday. New York grade buying prices were quoted from 24 cents for jumbos to 15 cents for crax and Egg Depot buying prices were 22 cents for large extras and 19 cents for extra mediums.

Poultry buying prices advanced a cent a pound in nearly all grades.

## FOR'S MESSAGE HAS NO EFFECT ON STOCK MART

NEW YORK, Jan. 6.—(AP.—) Wall Street studied the president's message to Congress today but apparently found little in it to stir the stock market's speculative pulse.

Prices shuffled along indecisively throughout the proceedings. Selected Oils, Utilities, Rails and Specialties pushed upward while Steels, Coppers and other leaders backed away.

Concern was still evident over the Automobile strike, although Chrysler and General Motors stiffened as federal conciliators put forth efforts to bring about a settlement.

Transfers were around 1,900,000 shares.

### PORTLAND BUTTER PRICES UNCHANGED

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 6.—(AP.—) Butter, eggs and butterfat prices were unchanged today.

Big demand continued for chickens. Vegetable prices advanced generally as a direct influence of the cold snap. Celery, lettuce, root vegetables and cabbage were affected chiefly.

Orange advances of 10 to 25 cents were recorded. Advances only in better grades.

Onion market was quiet.

Calavos struck a new low.

Brussels sprouts were firmly priced.

Cheese was steady.

Lemons were firm.

Nuts went slowly, with prices weak in practically all divisions.

Local potato prices were erratic, and showed considerable spread for similar offerings of even brands and qualities. A late advance asked and obtained in a limited way at Oregon-Washington sources, caused the price to boom to \$2.75 per cental. Retailers, however, would not pay that price for any material supply, while consumers saved leftovers and therefore reduced their buying volume.
