her life, but she has never felt the lure of Hollywood.

"I prefer character parts and intellectual acting and the best field for that is the legitimate stage. Motion pictures are so commercialized that they cannot be considered true art and I believe acting is an art. I do not believe motion pictures are drama in the strict sense of the word. The only motion pictures I have seen in recent months that would consider true drama were 'Craig's Wife' and 'Winter Set'."

Princess Dorothy graduated from Eugene high school in 1935 and for the past two years has been a

student at the University of Oregon. While at the university, she has been interested in stage technique and at present is managing "props" for the summer campus play.

"Chasing props comes off near being a pet peeve as anything I can think of," she says. "I have been doing so much of it that I am almost afraid to go into the stores here for fear they will think I am back to borrow something."

ARMIES POISED FOR WAR IN FAR EAST

ing that the issues are national and must be settled through the diplomatic representatives of the two countries.

Otherwise, Nanking officials avowed, China will be forced to use her army to resist what Chinese believe is Japan's effort to attack Hopeh and Chahar provinces, just as Manchuria was detached from China proper and set up as the state of Manchouguo in 1932.

Japan's war minister, General Gen Sugiyama, warned a council of prefectural governors that the situation may take a more grave turn at any moment.

He urged the 50 governors to prepare for mobilization of troops and be ready to requisition necessary supplies for the army's operations against China.

Three million army and navy reservists were told to hold themselves ready for a possible call.

"He has the military situation at his fingertips," a Nanking spokesman said.

The crisis developed on July 7, when Chinese and Japanese troops clashed at Marco Polo bridge 10 miles west of Peking. Trister clashes followed, and Japan demanded the withdrawal of Chinese troops from the battle area, recognition of her "special rights" to develop Hopeh and Chahar provinces economically, and a campaign against communism in China.

These are demands voiced often in the past by Japan, and the Marco Polo clash provided the opportunity for their renewal with more vigor and show of force than before. Japan already has considerable economic influence in the two provinces, and has kept a strong garrison in the Peking-Tientsin district.
