### BONNEVILLE POWER MAY COME TO CITY

(CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1) the coming winter, Eugene consumers will be taxing the present system almost beyond capacity.

Completion of the new transmission line, now being built from Leaburg to Eugene, will increase the amount of power delivered here by a slight amount, McArthur says.

Approximately 1000 more kilowatts can be brought to the city in the new line which will eliminate many power leaks existing in the old line.

At the present time, during construction of the new line, the power delivered to the city is slightly less due to losses through leaks and through construction work.

Thus the present electric utility is believed adequate for furnishing power needed by Eugene for one and one-half years to two years, but present growths indicate that after that time, the capacity will be reached and additional power will be needed.

The steam standby plant is expected to furnish additional power to carry peak loads for the next two years, but if present growth continues, still more power must be found, McArthur says.

It is this additional power, needed to carry the peak loads which demand more electricity than the city's utility can produce, that Eugene may obtain from the Bonneville project, provided distribution is provided and rates are right.

"If we can buy power from Bonneville for around five mills per kw-hr, it will pay the city to do so, rather than to build additional units on our own system," the superintendent declared.

"Present indications are that we will be able to get power at about that price, but that is one of the
