

Wheat Up 2 Cents in Local Market

Wholesale Price Of Cheese Drops Half Cent Here

Wheat advanced two cents in the Eugene market Monday, 74 cents a bushel being offered by the Eugene Mill and Elevator company.

The wholesale price of cheese to retailers was down half a cent a pound, single loaves being quoted at 15 1/2 cents a pound and in case lots 14 1/2 cents. Single loaves were 14 1/2 cents and in case lots 13 1/2 cents.
