Grant Takes State Prep Track Title

Elliott Cracks Shot Mark Again

Axemen Batters 54; Mohawk Runner Stars

Portland's Grant high school annexed the 13th annual Oregon championships on Hayward field state high school track and field Saturday afternoon, but Lane county made its best showing in years.

The well-balanced Generals rolled up a point total of 28 mostly on points outside of the winning 5's, while Eugene, Mohawk and Cottage Grove high schools garnered 18 points between them.

Lane county's greatest bid for fame came when Chuck Elliott, 230-pound Axeman shot putter, bettered his new state record with a heave of 54 feet, 1 1/2 inches, almost two feet better than the mark set here in 1937 by Bill Blackledge of Corvallis.

A third state record was tied by Gibson of Washington who topped the low timbers in the 200-yard hurdles in 23 flat, the same mark made by Brady of Washington last year at Corvallis.

Probably the outstanding individual performance as far as local fans were concerned—outside of Elliott's record-breaking shot put—was the sparkling running of Wally Hopkins of Mohawk high.
