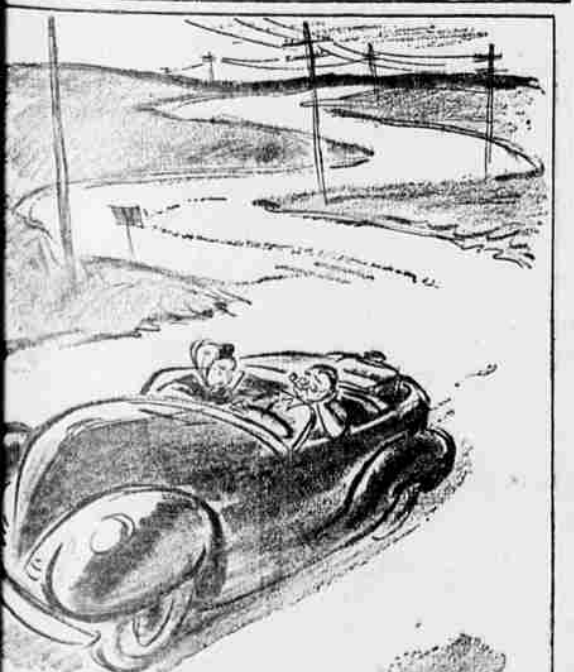
VISITS FROM NORWAY

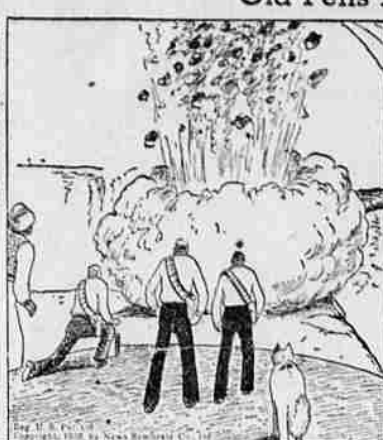

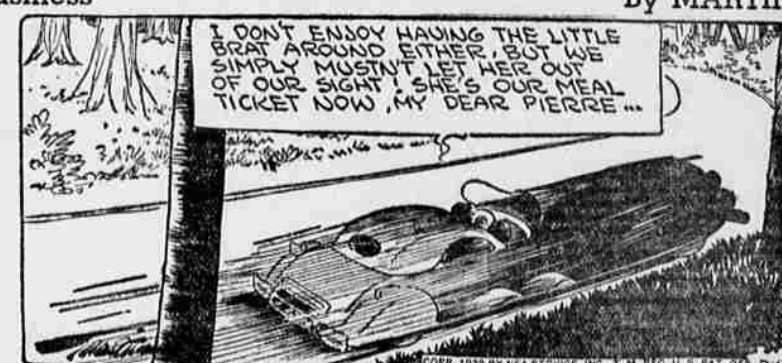

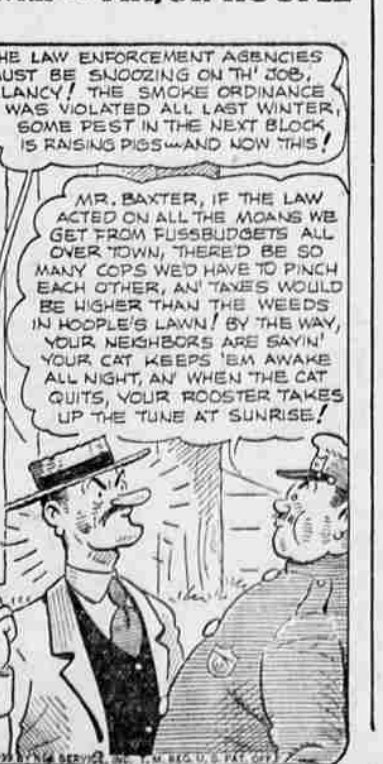
