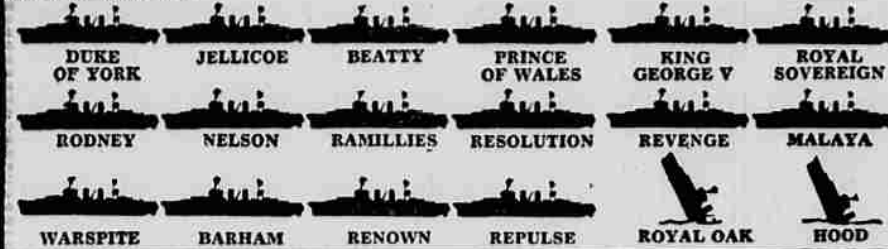


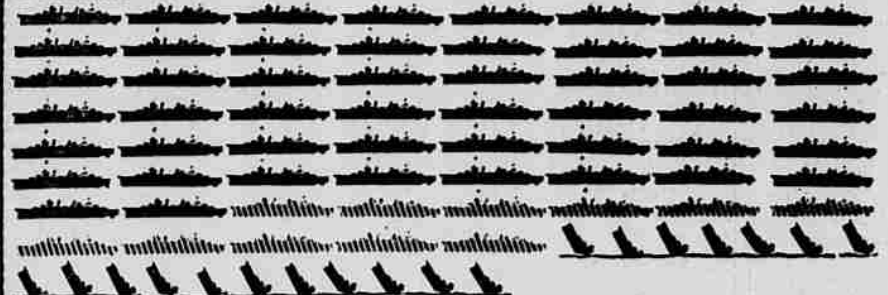
BATTLESHIPS



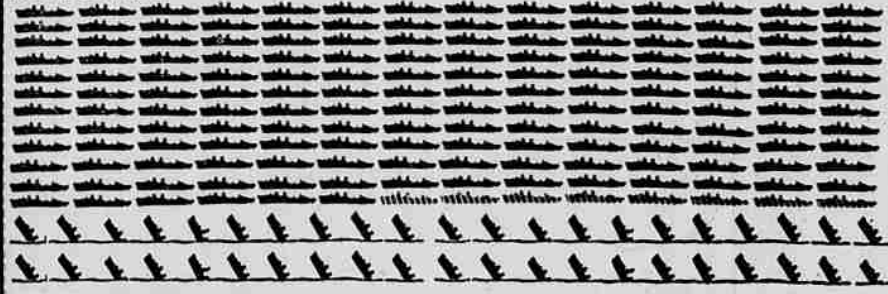
