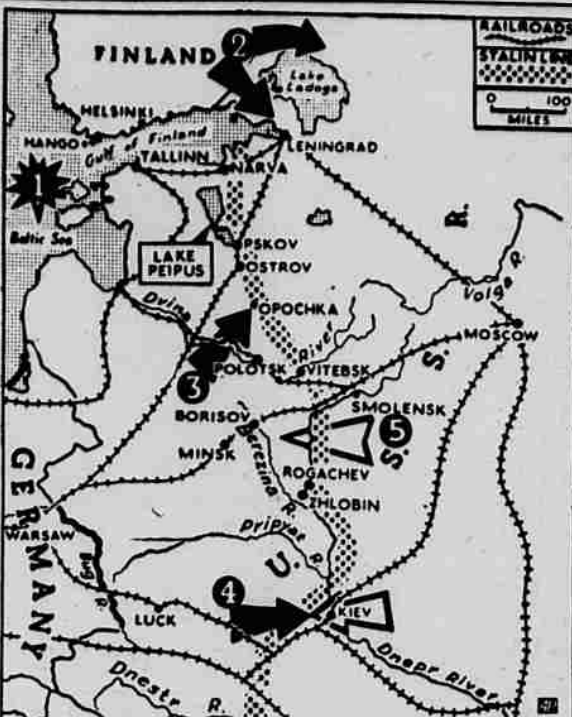

Coos Bay Pirates Don't Need No Invitation to Pageant -- They're A-Comin' Anyway

The Coos Bay Pirates are out to beat the time of the Grants Pass Cavemen, as far as the Oregon Trail Pageant is concerned, text of a letter received by Oregon Trail Pageant officials discloses. Eugeneans, already harassed by the mutterings of the Cavemen, who apparently believe they will take over Eugene Friday on the day of the pioneer parade, had this to digest from the Cavemen: "Weak-hearted Wintler, indigestible parade chief, Eugene, Oregon. "Take back your invitation, scum! When the Coos Bay Pirates want to honor any festivities by their presence, they do so without consulting anyone; they go where they choose, they take what they want, and they go when they have looted to their hearts' content. "Prepare to answer why you are making your plans without consulting the Pirates. Blood will flow in a crimson stream down the scraggly little hills of Lane county to the sea; there will be sorrow in the cramped and stuffy dwellings of Eugene; the streets and alleys, narrow, crooked thoroughfares, will be littered with carrion, if any varlet among you grows so bold as to question, or to halt, or even to look cross-eyed at the Pirates who plan to invade your cross-roads, if such can be found Thursday, July 24. "When the Pirates arrive, make way quickly or our cutlasses will cut a swath through any barrier, be they of human bodies or of steel. We will head your little party July 24. Beautiful women, if such may be found in Lane county, will be seized as hostages. "In return, the Pirates will bring with them a cooling breeze from Coos Bay, the treasure chest of Oregon. Our blood is pledged to avenge your slight upon our honor. We will have revenge. BEWARE! "The Oregon Trail Pageant Association's reply, by George P. Hitchcock, manager of the Pageant, was this: "Those pseudo-wildmen from Grants Pass were enough to bother with, but now with you coming a day before hand we'll have a tough time convincing people that only a wild-west atmosphere will prevail, and not the tea-party, pantywaist celebration your two organizations are wont to put on. "However, you may as well come down, so the Eugeneans will appreciate more the rough, tough and handsome men we have here. But you'd better behave, or we'll have one of our rookie policemen toss your whole outfit in the clink."

Home Size Important Building Factor

When the time for actual planning of a home has arrived, one of the primary questions to be answered is "how large must the home be?" It is best answered by deciding on the number of rooms required to meet the needs of the family, their size and their height. When you are visualizing your home, remember that a house has three dimensions — length depth and height. A room 10x10 feet, which adds only 100 square feet of floor space, adds also 100 square feet of ceiling, 320 square feet or more of wall (depending upon the ceiling height) and necessitates additional doors and windows, plus additional labor by masons, carpenters and plasterers. The three principal rooms in the home are generally considered the living room, dining room and kitchen; and it is a safe plan to give considerable thought to the layout and size of these three rooms first. Then plan the rest of the house accordingly. The overall dimensions of the house will depend to a large extent upon the style of house you build. The style should be definitely settled in advance because it is both confusing and expensive to make changes after construction has been started. After your house is thoroughly
