Power Shortage In Northwest Foreseen

SEATTLE, Aug. 13. — (P) — A City

Light official disclosed yesterday that a power shortage in the Pacific Northwest in 1943 might necessitate a rationing of electricity. "They warned me that they might have to ask us to cut out

electric ranges," said Isaac Comeaux, chief city accountant and financial adviser to the municipally-owned City Light. Comeaux said he informed the federal officials during a Washington, D. C., conference that be-

cause of Seattle's dependence upon electricity for cooking, many homes are not even equipped with kitchen flues, "making the installation of any other types of stove impossible."

Comeaux made the disclosure after City Light asked the city council for \$350,000 to permit immediate reopening of a Lake Washington steam plant because doubling of the agency's power load made too heavy a drag on the Slaght water storage.
