

Winn Promoted To District Supervisor

Dale Winn, in charge of the Eugene office of the Farm Security Administration the past three and a half years, has been promoted to the office of district supervisor with headquarters in Portland. He left Eugene Friday afternoon for Portland to assume his new duties immediately. His district covers all counties north of Marion and west of the Cascades in Oregon. Mr. Winn has had charge of the local office of the FSA in the federal building, since February, 1935. He is succeeded here by Norman Fletcher, who has been with the organization at Ontario, Ore., in charge of the rural real estate program in Malheur county. Mr. Fletcher plans to maintain the same hours at the local office as Mr. Winn did. They are from 9 to 4 on Mondays, 9 to 12 on Wednesdays and 9 to 11 on Saturdays.
