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Explorer To Speak At Lighthouse Temple February 22, 23, 24

Dr. J. O. Kinnaman, archaeologist and lecturer, will be the main speaker at the Lighthouse Temple in Eugene Sunday, Monday and Tuesday. Dr. Kinnaman has spent 52 years in the archaeological field and was one of the 22 explorers who entered the tomb of King Tut, being one of the two remaining survivors of that expedition.

Dr. Kinnaman served as editor of the American Antiquarian and Oriental Journal and is a member of the Palestine Exploration Fund of Great Britain; the Victoria Institute of Great Britain; the Society for the Study of Apocrypha; the International Society of Archaeologists.

Sunday morning Dr. Kinnaman will speak on "The Child Whom Jesus Blessed," or "The Last Surviving Man Who Knew Jesus." Sunday night, "Daniel in the Lions Den in the Light of Archaeology." Monday night, "Trailing the Exodus," illustrated by slides taken himself on his explorations of the Sinai. Tuesday night will close the series with, "Ting Tut and His Relation to the Bible and Archaeology." The public is invited to attend.
