Dr. Bonsall To Conduct Conference

Dr. Edward H. Bonsall, dean of Parsons College, Iowa, will conduct the inter-church young people's conference in Eugene on March 11. Dr. Bonsall, affectionately referred to as "Bonnie" by the young people who know him, is guest speaker at the Oregon Older Girls' 30th conference at Oregon City this week-end, where Mrs. Genevieve Turnipseed is a member of the advisory council.

The Eugene conference will take place at St. Mary's Episcopal church, the program commencing at 4 p.m., with a devotional period. A program on young people's activities in local churches will follow, with Dr. Bonsall as leader.

At 6 p.m. a covered dish supper with entertainment including community singing will be held. The church young people's inspirational assembly, to begin at 7:30 p.m., is open to all young people. The message will be by Dr. Bonsall.
