

Lane County Churches Observe Easter With Special Services and Programs

Church Notes

Beginning with the interdenominational Easter Sunrise service at 6:45 a. m. in McArthur court, Easter Sunday will progress, marked by as many separate observances as there are churches in Lane county.

At Central Presbyterian Church a special Easter breakfast for high school young people will be held in the chapel. Dr. Q. Breen will speak. Each Sunday school department will have its own program. Christening and baptism of babies will be held at the 11 o'clock service. A sacred Easter concert of choruses will be given in the evening by the senior choir, vocal solos by Margaret Zimmerman and W. Cook, violin solo by Elizabeth Walker, and organ chimes by Mrs. S. E. Stevens. Edna Leslie Pearson will direct the program.

Prof. H. C. Franchere of the University of Oregon will speak at the 8:30 forum Sunday evening at Westminster House. His topic will be "Students." An 8:30 Easter breakfast will be held at Westminster house Sunday morning.

"The Life of Christ Framed in Song" will be presented at the First Baptist church Sunday night at 7:30 o'clock. Three choirs will participate in the presentation. "From Darkness to Dawn" will be the theme of the Easter message Sunday morning.

Holy baptism will be administered at the morning service in the Emmaus Lutheran church. A special Easter program will be given Sunday evening at 7 o'clock in charge of the Dorcas society. Refreshments will be served in the church parlor following this program.

Special services are to be conducted at the Baptist chapel. Eleventh and Chambers streets each evening at 7:30 o'clock from April 25 to May 2. Rev. Kenneth A. Tobias will conduct the services and the first message Sunday evening will be "What the Absentee Missed." Special music in each service will be provided by the young people's groups.

Lighthouse Temple will present an Easter musical program Sunday night and an illustrated sermon on the subject, "Is the Resurrection Fact or Fancy." New members will be received into the church Sunday morning.

Easter Sunday will start at 6:30 a. m. for the St. Mary's Episcopalians, when the choral communion is presented. From 8 until 12:30 o'clock Holy communion will be administered. Baptism and church school will be at 9:45 a. m. and morning prayer and the sermon will take place at 11 o'clock.

At 9:45 a. m. the Fairmount Presbyterian church Sunday school will present an Easter program, at which a service flag will be dedicated. Parents of the children are invited by the Sunday school to attend the program and the church service which follows.

Young people of the First Christian church are sponsoring an Easter breakfast at 8 o'clock at McCrady's cafe. Dr. William C.
