month," the seaman related. "The captain was a good seaman, but he went out of his head." The schooner "began leaking a couple of weeks before we rounded Cape Horn," Gallagher said, "and after that we stood up to the hips in water in her hold and pumped by hand, day and night. The captain got sick at about the same time. We didn't know what was the matter then, but later, when he died in Durban, the doctor said he had a brain tumor."

Gallagher said he left Africa in February while the crew members' suit for most of their pay was still pending. The Commodore had been sold at auction for \$65,000.

Latham Women Asked To Meeting

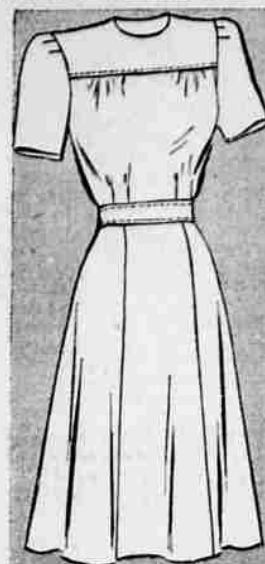
