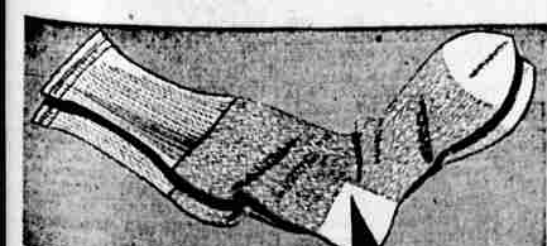

Air Force Board To Visit Eugene

An aviation cadet examining board, headed by Major Eric K. Shilling, will visit Eugene September 29 and 30. Lieutenant Hazel Acord of the army recruiting station, announced Tuesday.

Major Shilling is on a special mission to Oregon to stimulate an aviation cadet recruiting program. The army air force has urgent need for men between 17 and 28, it is said. The heavy production of planes and the increased role of airpower in fighting has raised the demand for more aviators, Major Shilling reveals.

Qualified 17-year-olds may enlist in the army air force reserve. Upon enrolling they will be given official aviation cadet "silver wings" to be worn on their civilian clothing, to indicate that they are future army fliers. They will not be called until their 18th birthday and until they are called they can continue their civilian employment or education.

Men 18 to 26 inclusive, who have

not received their induction papers, may take the cadet examinations and if qualified will be authorized to volunteer for induction in the air force.

Governor Snell has urged utmost cooperation to insure the success of this aviation cadet program.
