The afternoon session will be from 2 to 4:30 p.m. At 6:15 p.m. there will be a basket dinner to which all members and friends are invited. The evening service will be at 7:30 p.m., with Dr. Vance H. Webster presiding. The First Baptist church of Springfield is cooperating with the Eugene church. World Parish day programs also will be held at Cottage Grove on Thursday and at Veneta and Junction City on Friday.

## Missionary From China At Creswell

CRESWELL—The Rev. Perry Oliver Hanson, missionary of the Methodist church in Shantung Province, "China's holy land" will be the guest-speaker at the Methodist church in Creswell, Sunday, November 7, at 7:30 p. m. Mr. Hanson will speak from forty years' experience as a Christian evangelist, builder of churches and schools and superintendent of a hospital in the region around Taishan, the oldest sacred mountain in the world, and the land where millions of pilgrims have travelled through more than 5000 years in order to worship.

Perhaps no man in China better knows the nation's sacred province and the various sects of Buddhist, Taoist, Confucianist and Mohammedan who live there than does Mr. Hanson.

Mr. Hanson was born in Darlington, Wis., and received his education at the University of Minnesota. Before sailing to China in 1903 he was married to Miss Ruth Ewing of St. Paul, Minn. They have seven children, three boys and four girls, six of whom were born in China.
