M., January 17, 1944, for all the live timber marked and designated for cutting and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing about 10 acres within the 25th Sec. 4, and 26th Sec. 7, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. 1/2 N. 1/2 W. National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 800,000 ft. B. M. more or less of sugar pine, and 67,000 ft. B. M. more or less of Douglas-fir and other species of sawtimber. No bid of less than \$2.00 per M. ft. for Douglas-fir and sugar pine and \$1.40 per M. ft. for hemlock and other species will be considered. In addition to the price bid for the stumpage, a cooperative deposit of \$1.00 per M. ft. B. M. to be used by the Forest Service for paying a portion of the cost of slash disposal, for the total cut of timber under the terms of the agreement, and for the cost of the timber in excess of the permissible under MFR 460 will be reduced to the actual maximum in making the award. \$500.00 must accompany each bid, to be applied on the purchase price, and, or retained in part as liquidated damages according to conditions of sale.
