OPA Issues Wood Pulp Top Prices

WASHINGTON—(AP)—In an effort to halt diversion of wood needed as fuel, the office of price administration has announced that producers' prices for firewood in the western half of the United States may not exceed existing maximum prices for firewood established at the producers' level through local pricing orders.

Effective July 8, the action will result in some control of prices for pulpwood which were exempted from price control a short time ago to encourage diversion of pulpwood to woodpulp production.

OPA said this resulted in a serious diversion of labor and production from firewood which trends to impair the already critical fuel supply situation in areas west of the 100th meridian.

OPA said the new action allows some local price adjustments to be made in favor of pulpwood where deemed necessary.

SPRINGFIELD.—Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Roberts and daughter, Kristin of Portland are visiting relatives in Springfield this week.

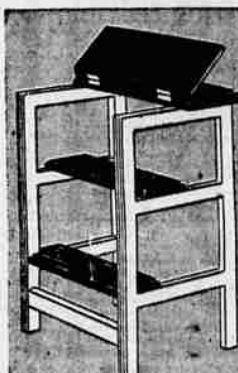

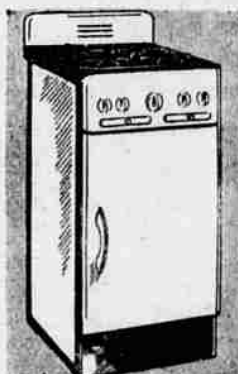

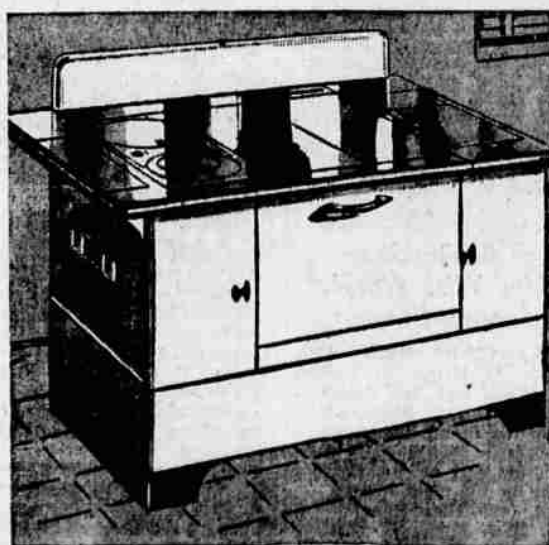
