

Bulletin on Soil Erosion Published

SALEM, Ore.—The state department of geology and mineral industries has announced publication of a bulletin dealing with the origin, destruction and preservation of "our most valuable mineral resource," soil.

Written by Dr. W. H. Twenhofel, of the University of Wisconsin geology department, the publication surveys destruction of soil by erosion and sedimentation, and reviews conservation possibilities from a geologist's standpoint. The bulletin is available at the department's offices in Portland, Grants Pass and Baker.
