valley have originated he said, from people throwing cigarettes from train and auto windows.

Logging operators suspected of violating state fire prevention laws were being approached by state inspectors. At Cottage Grove two operators were brought before justice court after being apprehended by H. L. Young, state forester inspector for this district. Oliver Ramalia was fined \$50 and costs on a charge of providing no watchman service on his logging operation on the coast fork of the Willamette above London. J. C. Smith, Culp Creek logging operator, was cited to appear Wednesday for allegedly operating with the humidity below 30.

The only fire of consequence reported in Oregon was at the Umpqua divide in southern Oregon where 100 acres were burned before fire crews managed to check

the blaze, according to United Press.

Coos Patrols Active

At the same time Coos Bay fire patrols today were checking for forest fires which may be causing a heavy cloud of smoke which hangs over the Coos Bay area. Some observers believe, however, that a shift of wind brought the smoke from a 400-acre brush and grass fire burning stubbornly south of Charleston. Fire patrolmen reported that the fire has been kept from standing timber so far, although it has been creeping through logs and underbrush for more than a week.

At Silverton a barn full of hay was destroyed on the A. E. Reed farm in the Evans Valley district.

In and around Portland seven grass and brush fires were reported but they have all been brought under control. Two grass fires in Eugene Wednesday were extinguished, fire department records show.

Two fires occurred Tuesday in Portland only five blocks apart. One destroyed the Cervetto pig feeding farm and killed some 500 pigs. A three-acre grass fire started by a cigaret burned the Union Auto Wrecking yard. Near Wenatchee, Wash., one fire already has blackened 600 acres of grass and timber and farther up the Cascades in the same area another blaze is under control of a 15-man crew after burning 200 acres of scrub pine, hemlock and fir for a week.
