**STUFFED VEGETABLES**  
Select firm, large tomatoes. Scoop out centers. Sprinkle inside with salt and dot with butter or margarine. Fill with stuffing. Cook large onions 20 min. in simmering water. Remove a small portion from center. Fill with stuffing. Wilt cabbage leaves, stuff, fold over and tie securely. Bake all vegetables 15-30 min. in a moderate oven (350 F.) or until tender.

**MEAT STUFFING**  
4 tbs. meat drippings • 1 pound hamburger • 1 cup dry bread crumbs • 1/2 cup chopped green pepper • 1/2 cup chopped celery • 1/2 cup water • Salt to taste. Mix lightly together and stuff into vegetables. Stuff 16 vegetables.

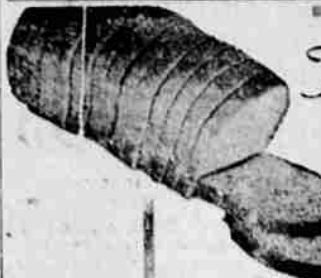
Eight states and the nation's capital on the Atlantic seaboard

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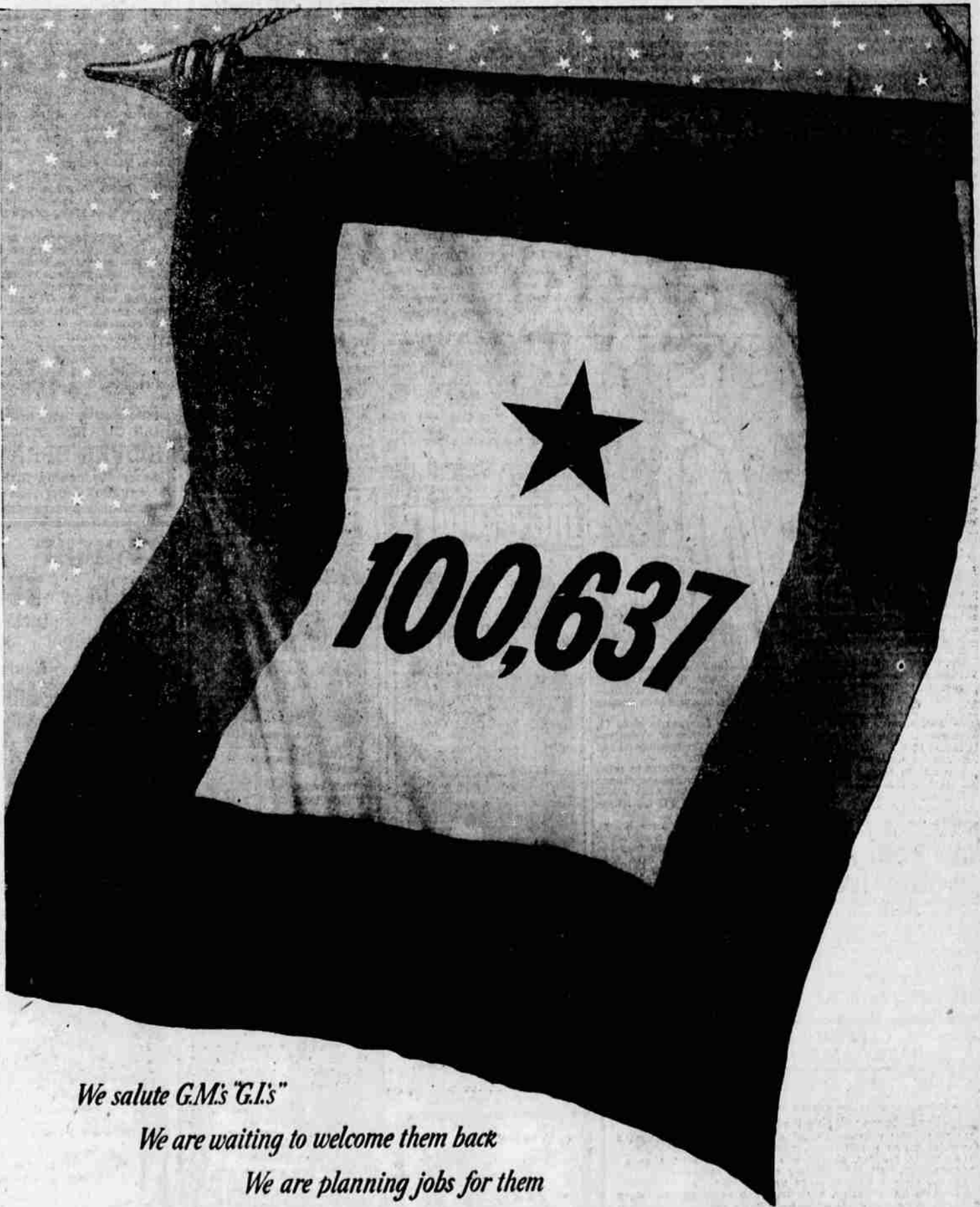
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
