

Price Relax Aids Low-Grade Lumber

A loosening up of the low grade lumber market in the Lane area was predicted Wednesday with the announcement from the OPA that, effective Saturday, price ceiling changes would be applied to low-grade lumber on sale to farmers.

According to reports low-grade items under present ceilings have been piling up here, as distributing yards will not handle them because of the small quantities sold and the limited mark-up, with the result that they can make greater profits on more expensive lumber grades.

Distributors, who heretofore have been held to the wholesale mark-up of \$5 and 10 per cent above the mill price per 1000 feet, may now price lower-grade lumber on the same basis as other grades.

AAA Staff Instructed On Compliance Checking

Twenty-nine community committeemen and the office force of the Lane county agricultural conservation association Wednesday attended a school of instruction on making the compliance check under the 1944 agricultural conservation program. Instruction was given by A. N. Botker, field man for the state AAA office.

Plans were made to start compliance checking the first of next week, most of the work being done in the county AAA office in the public market building. The plan will be to set certain days for the various communities to come in and one those days the community committeemen will be in the office to assist in taking reports. The schedule is now being prepared.

The meeting Wednesday was called by the county AAA committee and George W. Platt, chairman of the county committee, presided.

Nazi Weather Station In Greenland Seized

WASHINGTON, Oct. 12—(AP)—A German weather station, believed to be the last one in Greenland, was located and captured last week, army air force sources revealed. Three officers, nine men and quantities of technical radio, ordnance and scientific equipment were captured, it was reported.

Limited Mail Service To France Announced

All except 12 of the 90 departments of France, and the territory of Belfort, will have limited mail service with the United States under an order of Postmaster General Frank C. Walker, which becomes effective today.

The departments which are not embraced in the order are: Charente-Inférieure, Doubs, Loire-Inférieure, Meurthe-et-Moselle, Meuse, Morbihan, Moselle, Bas-Rhin, Haut-Rhin, Haute-Saône, Vosges, Basses Pyrénées, Landes and Gironde.

On Oct. 15, the service will be extended to the departments of Basses Pyrénées, Landes and Gironde.

The service is restricted to non-illustrated post-cards of a personal character written in English or French.

FDR Stresses Need Of Fair Trade System

NEW YORK, Oct. 12—(AP)—President Roosevelt said last night that the United States, for its own salvation, must cooperate with other like-minded nations in establishing a sound and equitable system of commercial and economic relationships among all countries.

In a message to the final session of the 31st national foreign trade council convention, Roosevelt emphasized that "a vigorous and expanding international trade is indispensable to such a system."

He pointed out that the "opportunity for the citizens of every country to trade with the citizens of other countries, fairly and without unnecessary and uneconomic restrictions, and without discrimination, oppression or aggression, is essential to world economic security and therefore to world peace."

More Filbert Pickers Needed To Save Crop

More filbert pickers are needed to save the crop in this county, Harry Bower, county farm labor assistant, announced Thursday. Growers could use 50 more right now and when the nut harvesting work reaches its peak next week there will be a demand for still more.

The labor supply from the schools is about to be exhausted and the nut growers will have to depend upon older people from this time on, Bower said. Only a certain number of school children from each grade was allowed to go out each day and this allotment is almost used up.

The OPA said the sum represented above-ceiling prices charged to various industrial firms during a year's period on non-standard sizes of pine lumber.

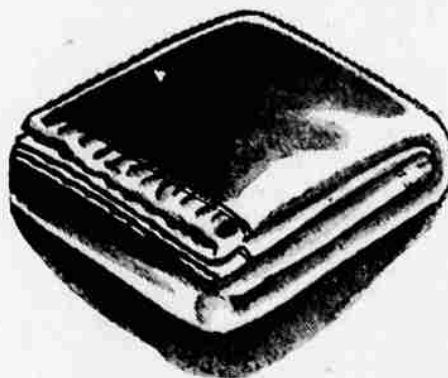
