The rest are scattered over all the states. In Oregon we have 17,981; in Washington, 86,893; in California, 276,012.

Not all of the 2,837,010 on the executive payroll are mere political jobholders subject to the political will. Some few in every outfit are people drafted for war service who have no political ties. But the vast majority of the 2,837,010 are nothing but JOB HOLDERS.

We who live 3,000 miles from Washington are the worst sufferers from the plague. Under the New Deal plan the man in the field is never given power to act, no matter how wise or well informed he may be. All authority must go back to Washington.
