

Dr. Laubach To Be Visitor In Eugene

Dr. Franck C. Laubach, American Congregational missionary educator, who is internationally known through his amazing work for the illiterate peoples of the world, will speak at First Congregational church, Monday, Nov. 20, at 8 p.m. No admission will be charged, but an offering will be taken.

Dr. Laubach, who already has started his remarkable service to illiterates, whom he calls "the forgotten peoples of the world," in India, Africa, Ceylon, Turkey, Malaysia, Mexico and South America, began this work by developing a simple method of teaching illiterates among the Moslem Moros of Mindanao, Philippine Islands. Now, the Laubach system, tested and found pedagogically sound by Columbia University educators, has been applied to 80 or more languages and dialects. This system enables illiterates, picked at random from street or field, to read in an incredibly short time. Some have learned in less than an hour, others take a day or several days, depending upon the IQ of the pupil and the difficulty of his language or dialect. His work recently was written up in Readers Digest.

Dr. Laubach recently has returned from a second highly successful tour through Latin American countries in the interests of literacy. He met with government, educational and church leaders, both Protestant and Roman Catholic, for the help he brings to countries with literacy problems surmounts all barriers of creed or language. In country after country the president, governors of provinces, heads of education departments, city officials and educators in all types of schools, responded enthusiastically to the Laubach system, and began or planned campaigns in their areas.

Dr. Laubach's Latin American tour, done mostly by air, took him to Colombia, Peru, Ecuador, Bolivia, Mexico, Cuba, Haiti (where he was decorated by the president) Jamaica, Santo Domingo, Puerto Rico, Paraguay and Trinidad. On this trip he adapted his system not only to Spanish and Portuguese but to Indian dialects and to Creole.

Those closest to Dr. Laubach say that he is an unbeatable combination of realist and idealist. A trained psychologist and educator, he also is a mystic. Dr. Laubach insists that the successful teacher of illiterates "must first make his pupil feel his love and understanding for him." A prolific writer, Dr. Laubach is the author of books on the Philippines, on literacy and on religion. His latest book is "The Silent Billion Speak."
