\$9136 Suit Filed

Fourth of Trucks Stranded On Rims

Howard S. Merriam, member of the state emergency truck tire panel of the office of price administration, Thursday said that 25 per cent of all trucks in Lane county are off the road for lack of tires. Only the most essential will get tires, he said.

A United Press dispatch from Portland quoted R. B. Eversole, assistant manager of the Portland office of defense transportation, as saying, "The emergency truck tire panel has been forced to deny many applications for new tires because operators were neglectful of their tires, and therefore the trucks had to go out of service. The tire situation is at its most critical stage of the war, and if the European fight goes into summer our motor transportation system will be subjected to increasingly difficult expedients."

Enclosed also must be an envelope with name of the play on the outside, and the author's name inside. Manuscripts may be sent to any one of the following: Mrs. Alice Henson Ernst, associate professor of English at the University; Mrs. Clara L. Fitch, secretary of the university graduate school; or Mr. L. K. Shumaker, general supervisor of Eugene public schools. Winner of the contest will receive a cash prize of not less than ten dollars in addition to having his play produced by the Very Little Theatre group as the group judges suitable.

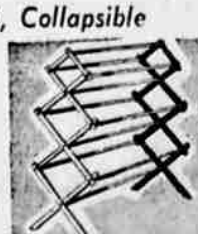
