

Ballet Conductor Is Able Composer

Fritz Berens, musical conductor of the San Francisco ballet company, is coming to Eugene for two morning

and one evening performance on April 10, is known as a composer of recognized ability both in America and in Europe. Berens has been with the San Francisco Ballet company for four years and has also conducted the San Francisco Symphony orchestra. It was Berens who conducted

for the initial performance of the Swan Lake ballet of Tchaikovsky in its entirety to a capacity audience at the war memorial opera house in San Francisco. The second act of the Swan Lake ballet will be given at the evening performance here. Born in Vienna, Berens studied

at the famous conservatory there. Later he conducted in cities throughout Europe. In addition to Swan Lake, the company will present "In Old Vienna," a ballet set to the lilt of waltzes of Johann Strauss and the "Nutcracker Suite" ballet founded on Tchaikovsky's famous

music. for the evening program. Only the latter two will be given at the morning performances for school children. The San Francisco Ballet company, now one of the best in America, is coming to Eugene under the auspices of the education activities office at the University

of Oregon, of which Horace W. Robinson is acting director, and the Junior Programs group, with Mrs. R. D. Horn in charge.
