### Russians Send Troops To Occupy Kuriles, Report

WASHINGTON, Jan. 17. — (AP) — Russia was reported today to be establishing herself firmly in the strategic Kurile island chain flanking the approaches to Siberia.

It was from a rendezvous in these foggy Japanese islands that Admiral Yamamoto's fleet set out in late November, 1941, for its attack on Pearl Harbor.

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for a long stay. These officials cannot be identified by name. Agreement upon Russian occupation of these islands, stretching like a giant scimitar across the entrance to the sea of Okhotsk, was reached at the Potsdam conference.

Japan's Title  
Back in the last century there was some dispute between Russia and Japan as to the ownership of these barren islands, but in 1875 Moscow officially recognized Japan's title to the Kuriles.

It appeared likely that President Truman had the Kuriles in mind Tuesday when he told his news conference it was not necessarily true that the United States would be alone in seeking independent control of former enemy-held islands.

But it remained at least temporarily uncertain whether Russia will lay its claim to the Kuriles formally before the United Nations, as the U. S. plans to do with key Pacific bases won in the war.
