Oregon Milk Output

Below 10 Year Level
PORTLAND, Ore. —(U.P.)— Oregon milk production per cow at

the beginning of 1946 was above last year but somewhat below the 10-year average and the total number of cows on farms is somewhat less than a year ago, the U.

The average per cow was 12.6 pounds, as compared with 12.5 a year ago and 13.6 for the 10-year average. About 65 per cent of the

National milk production in 1945 was the largest in history, an estimated 123,000,000,000 pounds, or 4,000,000,000 more than the previous high mark in 1944. The production for December 1945 was 8,500,000,000 pounds, highest of all months except December, 1944.
